As you are aware, at Park Hall Academy we take our safeguarding responsibility extremely seriously, but we also need your support to keep our Park Hall family safe.

You can also contact the Stoke-on-Trent Safeguarding Children's Partnership on 01782 235100.

If you feel that your child is in immediate danger, call the police on 999. You can report concerns to the police on their non-emergency number, 101.

Visit the [See, Hear, Respond service](#) or call on 0800 157 7015 for additional support, advice and information during this period.

This includes online and face -to- face support for children and families, help for children at risk of harm outside of the home, and support to help vulnerable children successfully return to school.

If you are in immediate danger, call 999 and ask for the police. If you are unable to talk on the phone, listen to the questions from the operator and respond by coughing or tapping the handset if you can. Follow the instructions depending on whether you are calling from a mobile or landline.
